ROUCHETTE What is it?




Rouchette is a **French company** that has been **manufacturing boots** and shoes for **over 30 years!**

Your boot is **comfortable and eco-friendly.** Well done, little hero!



ANIMALS THREATENED BY POACHING



What is poaching?

Poaching is when **people catch or injure animals without permission**, even though it is **illegal**.

They do this to sell the animals or take parts of their bodies, such as their skin, fur, teeth or horns.

Sometimes female animals are killed so they can take their babies. It's like taking something precious from an animal without asking: it's very serious!

Why is it dangerous?

Because many animals are caught too quickly, without having time to reproduce or grow up. The result is that we see less and less of them, and some animals disappear forever.

How many animals are affected?

More than **7,000 species of animals** and plants are threatened by poaching around the world. This means that these animals could become extinct if no one protects them.

You can **talk about it** with others and ask **why it is important.**

ANIMALS THREATENED BY CLIMATE CHANGE



What is climate change?

It's when the Earth becomes too hot.

Normally, it is the **Sun that warms the Earth**. But now, **because of human activities**, such as **cars driving** around and **factories smoking**, there is a lot of **pollution in the air**. This pollution **keeps the heat from escaping**, and it stays trapped around the Earth... It's a bit Like putting a **big invisible blanket over the planet**, which makes it **too hot**.

Why is it dangerous?

- -Ice is melting at North and South Pole
- -Plants and animals may lose their homes and no longer know where to live
- There is less water, less snow, less food...

How many animals are affected?

Climate change is putting more than 1 million animal and plant species around the world in danger. Some animals live on ice and no longer have enough space to live, hunt, or have babies.



I live on the ice floe and near the sea.




I can live up to 20 years.

rescue birds and release them back into the wild

So put on your boots, come visit Bioparc, observe the animals, ask questions, and go home with a desire to protect the planet! Let's go on an adventure!










